Why We Are Running Away From PDP In Edo State.

he fortunes of the Peoples Democratic Party, PDP in Edo State are continuing to dwindle with both foundation members and later-day joiners abandoning the party in Edo State.

Interestingly, many of those who joined the party with Governor Godwin Obaseki after he was denied the ticket of the party in 2020 have also abandoned him in the party.

In nearly all cases, the blame for the exit has been heaped on Obaseki. Those who came with him into the PDP including some of his former aides like a former commissioner, Adaze Emwanta are blaming him for not being sincere with them and the new party they joined.

Those who received him into the PDP like Hon Martins Osakue are abandoning the house they laboured for over 25 years because the fortunes of the PDP began to collapse once Obaseki joined a former robust and vibrant party.

The PDP had even with the then ACN in power at the state level showed its worth in elections winning the majority of seats in the National Assembly.

However, with Obaseki as governor, the PDP in 2023 lost the majority of the seats in the National Assembly and for the first time did not have a representative in the Senate.

It is as such not surprising that in the approach to the governorship election that many are no longer wishing to resign themselves to fate.

It is worthy of note that many who cautioned against giving Obaseki shelter in 2020 after what he did to Comrade Adams Oshiomhole are now being proved to have been right.

Not only did he cast aside and "SUSPEND" Chief Dan Orbih who led his campaign in 2020, his sense of INGRATITUDE was also displayed in his "SUSPENSION" of Hon (Engr) Omoregie Ogbeide-Ihama, the man who surrendered the ticket to him in 2020.

It is thus understandable why there is a massive exit from the party following the decision of the PDP National Working Committee. NWC to handover the party to a man who by election results and personal relations has devalued the party.

The ominous signs cannot be better reflected by the lukewarm reception being given to Obaseki's agents as they traverse the state to shore up support for the governor and his Lagos-branded candidate who does not even understand our language.

Excerpts of the letters below reflect the story of why otherwise established political actors are running away from the PDP.

The Chairman Ugbogbo

I am writing to formally resign from The Peoples Democratic Party, effective immediately.

This decision has not been made lightly, but after considerable reflection, I find it absolutely necessary to take this

The PDP has changed radically in content and form negatively particularly over the last 4 years, that it has become almost unrecognisable as the party I joined with much enthusiasm in 1999.

I had the honour and privilege of serving the Party our State and Country as a Federal Commissioner in the

Presidency and in the Public Complaints Commission, then under the National Assembly.

I ran two elections to the National Assembly and supported several elections in every way imaginable including the election of the outgoing government in Edo State. Over the years, I have dedicated myself to the values and mission of our party.

In consequence I have been a major plank in my Federal constituency, my Senatorial district and indeed the State. Needless to say my Federal Constituency has consistently been the largest contributor to PDP votes in the Edo North Senatorial district.

However, recent actions and decisions by the Government and its leadership have profoundly conflicted with my personal values and the core principles I believed our party stood for.

It has become clear that the direction in which the party is heading is no longer one that I can, in good conscience,

I have always believed that politics should always be centred on persistent efforts at harmony, reward lovalty and consistency not friction and complete disregard for historical sacrifices and contributions from Senior party members

I have also always believed in integrity, transparency, and accountability in public service.

Unfortunately, the recent policies and strategies pursued by our government and its leadership reflect a deviation from these essential principles.

The disconnect between the party's current stance and my own beliefs makes it impossible for me to continue my association with the PDP.

My commitment to serving our community and working towards meaningful change remains unwavering.

I will continue to advocate for the issues that matter to me, albeit through different avenues that align more closely with my values and vision for our future.

I am grateful for the opportunities and experiences I have had during my time with the PDP.

I have had the privilege of working with many dedicated individuals, and I wish the party success in its future

Please consider this letter as my formal resignation from the PDP and all related roles and responsibilities. I trust that the necessary arrangements will be made promptly to reflect this change
